How to complete an online will:

1. Login to the website.
2. From the main menu, select "Services."
3. Click "Legal & Financial Services" in the drop down menu.
4. Select "Legal Tools/Forms."
5. When the Legal Resource Center opens, click "Personal Documents."
6. Choose your state.
7. Scroll down to the section called, "Wills, powers of attorney and estate planning."
8. Choose the document and click "Get started." You'll need to create a personal login to open the document. Do not use your company username and password in this section.

Note: It is suggested that you consider consulting with an attorney to be sure that you have taken the proper steps for your specific estate, personal and financial needs.
